## The List of Priority **Projects (LOPP)**

- » The LOPP is developed annually to define the highest priority unfunded transportation projects.
- » The LOPP serves as the bridge between priorities identified in the Long-Range Transportation Plan and projects programmed for funding in the FDOT Five-Year Work Program and MPO Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).
- » The Top 20 projects represent Tier 1 of the LOPP and the Top 5 are the most critical Tier 1 priorities.

## **The Lake-Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization** (LSMPO)

LSMPO provides a forum for cooperative decision-making regarding transportation priorities throughout the urbanized area of Lake and Sumter counties. As the lead agency for regional transportation planning, the MPO is responsible for planning a multimodal transportation network that serves current and emerging needs. The MPO helps citizens speak with one voice to their state and federal legislators on transportation- related issues.


