T.J. Fish provided information regarding the FDOT Tentative Work Program for 2019-23. He added FDOT is required to provide presentations. Project deferrals were discussed.

### **II. Status of State Road Projects and Funding**

T. J. Fish provided updates on the status of following state road projects and the funding of each project.

- A. SR 50 Project Development & Environment Study – CR 33 (Mascotte) to US 98 (Hernando)
- B. Construction Project to Build to Six Lanes: US 27 from Lake Louisa Road (Clermont) south to Boggy Marsh Road (Four Corners/South Clermont)
- C. Groveland SR 50 Realignment Right-of-Way Funding Request
- D. Future FDOT Studies: US 27, SR 33, SR 19

### **III. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise: Minneola Interchange, Mainline Widening, Bridges**

Staff provided update. Toll fees, SunPass and E-pass were discussed.

- G. CR 455 and Ridgewood Drive Intersection (Montverde)
- H. Villa City Road at US 27 (Groveland)
