A. Approval of March 12, 2018 Meeting Minutes

B. Review & Approval of FY 2018/19 Rate Calculation Model for Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund Trips for Lake County

Amy Bradford, Lake County Transit Division, presented the FY 2018/19 Rate Calculation Model for Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund Trips. Discussion continued.

On a motion by Colleen Kollmann, seconded by Bebe Chudeusz and carried unanimously by a 12-0 vote, the Board approved the FY 2018/19 Rate Calculation Model for Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund Trips for Lake County.

C. Review & Approval of the Transportation Disadvantaged Service Plan (TDSP) Annual Update

Which includes contracting with the University of South Florida, Center for Urban Transportation Research to update the Lake County TDSP. Michael Woods also asked for volunteers for a subcommittee to help with the update. Rickey Mack, Lesha Buchbinder, Bebe Chudeusz, and Timothy Bridges will serve on the subcommittee.

On a motion by Lesha Buchbinder, seconded by Colleen Kollmann and carried unanimously by a 12-0 vote, the Board approved The Transportation Disadvantaged Service Plan (TDSP) Major Update and subcommittee.
