RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE~SUMTER METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, AMENDING THE FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS (LOPP) TO ADD APPENDIX “A” AS A REFORMATTED LOPP IN WHICH PROJECTS ARE PRIORITIZED BASED ON PROJECT PHASING RATHER THAN BY FUNDING CATEGORY; AND AUTHORIZING TRANSMITTAL OF APPENDIX “A” TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Lake~Sumter Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 49 U.S.C. 5303 require that the urbanized area, as a condition for the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, has a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175(8)(a), requires that the MPO is responsible for developing, annually, a list of project priorities (LOPP) ranking the transportation needs of the MPO area; and

WHEREAS, the prevailing principles that must be considered by the MPO when developing the LOPP are preserving the existing transportation infrastructure, enhancing Florida’s economic competitiveness, and improving travel choices to ensure mobility; and

WHEREAS, the LOPP must be based upon project selection criteria that considers, in part, the MPO long range transportation plan; the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Strategic Intermodal System Plan; criteria consistent with projects eligible to receive funding from the Transportation Regional Incentive Program outlined in Florida Statutes 339.2819(4); the results of the transportation management systems; and the MPO public involvement plan; and

WHEREAS, the LOPP must be used by the FDOT in developing the five-year work program and must be used by the MPO in developing its transportation improvement program; and

WHEREAS, the MPO adopted the FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 LOPP for state funding for transportation projects on August 28, 2013, and transmitted it to FDOT; and

WHEREAS, the MPO has created Appendix A to the document that, rather than based on funding categories, is reformatted in order to prioritize projects based on phasing of the project, such as Study, PD&E, Design, Right-of-Way and Construction phases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lake~Sumter MPO:

1. The FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 List of Priority Projects is hereby amended to include Appendix "A" as a reformatted LOPP in which projects are prioritized based on project phasing rather than by funding category; and
2. The Chairman of the MPO is hereby authorized and directed to submit the list of priority projects to the Florida Department of Transportation and to the Chairman of both the Lake County and the Sumter County Boards of County Commissioners.

RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE~SUMTER METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, AMENDING THE FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS (LOPP); ADDING AS A NEW PROJECT SR 50 FROM US 98 TO CR 33 TO TABLE 3 AND APPENDIX TABLE 5; ADDING CR 466A FROM SUMTER COUNTY LINE TO SR 25/500 (US 27/441) TO TABLE 4 AND APPENDIX TABLE 2; ADDING CR 466A FROM SUNNY COURT TO SR 25/500 (US 27/441) TO TABLE 4 AND APPENDIX TABLE 1; REVISING THE LIMITS OF THE SOUTHERN TERMINUS OF THE WEKIVA TRAIL PROJECT NEIGHBORHOOD LAKES SEGMENT FROM KELLY PARK ROAD TO LAKE/ORANGE COUNTY LINE IN TABLE 7 AND APPENDIX TABLE 1; AND AUTHORIZING TRANSMITTAL TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Lake~Sumter Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 49 U.S.C. 5303 require that the urbanized area, as a condition for the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, has a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175(8)(a), requires that the MPO is responsible for developing, annually, a list of project priorities (LOPP) ranking the transportation needs of the MPO area; and

WHEREAS, the LOPP must be used by the FDOT in developing the five-year work program and must be used by the MPO in developing its transportation improvement program; and

WHEREAS, the MPO adopted the FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 LOPP for state funding for transportation projects on August 28, 2013, and transmitted it to FDOT; and

WHEREAS, the MPO amended the FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 LOPP on October 23, 2013 to include Appendix “A” as a reformatted LOPP in which projects are prioritized based on project phasing rather than by funding category; and

WHEREAS, SR 50 from US 98 to CR 33 is a two-lane road as it passes through Sumter County connecting four-lane segments on both east and west termini; and

WHEREAS, SR 50 from US 98 to CR 33 should be studied to determine when additional capacity on this segment may be needed or if safety improvements are needed; and

WHEREAS, CR 466A from the Sumter County Line east to SR 25/500 (US 27/441) needs to be clarified as a priority for right-of-way funding while, within that segment, CR 466A from Sunny Court east to SR 25/500 (US 27/441) needs to be clarified as a priority for construction funding; and

WHEREAS, the agreements between Lake County and FDOT for the funding of CR 466A have not been finalized, and both phases of CR 466A from the Sumter County Line to SR 25/500 (US 27/441) need to remain in the LOPP until the funding agreements are completed; and

WHEREAS, the design of the Neighborhood Lakes segment of the Wekiva Trail project is to extend from SR 46 in Lake County south to the Orange County Line, with Orange County to address design and construction of the trail south to Kelly Park Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lake~Sumter MPO:

1. The FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 List of Priority Projects is hereby amended to add SR 50 from US 98 to CR 33 to Table 3 and Appendix Table 5; and
2. The FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 List of Priority Projects is hereby amended to add CR 466A from Sumter County Line to SR 25/500 (US 27/441) to Table 4 and Appendix Table 2; and
3. The FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 List of Priority Projects is hereby amended to add CR 466A from Sunny Court to SR 25/500 (US27/441) to Table 4 and Appendix Table 1; and
4. The FY 2018/19 – FY 2024/35 List of Priority Projects is hereby amended to revise the limits of the southern terminus of the Wekiva Trail project, Neighborhood Lakes segment, from Kelly Park Road to a new terminus at the Lake/Orange County Line in Table 7 and Appendix Table 1; and

5. The Chairman of the MPO is hereby authorized and directed to submit the list of priority projects to the Florida Department of Transportation and to the Chairman of both the Lake County and the Sumter County Boards of County Commissioners.



WHEREAS, the MPO amended the FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 LOPP on October 23, 2013 to include Appendix "A" as a reformatted LOPP in which projects are prioritized based on project phasing rather than by funding category; and

WHEREAS, the MPO amended the FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 LOPP on December 11, 2013 to include a study of SR 50 from US 98 to CR 33 to determine future capacity needs; to add CR 466A from Sumter County Line to SR 25/500 (US 27/441) to clarify that this project is a funding priority; and to add CR 466A from Sunny Court to SR 25/500 (US27/441) to clarify that this project is a funding priority; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the Wekiva Protection Act, the State of Florida has purchased all of the Neighborhood Lakes properties, which has eliminated much of the potential for future development in the area; and

WHEREAS, a new segment of SR 429, also known as the Wekiva Parkway, will be open to traffic by January 2015 connecting CR 435 in Orange County north through the Neighborhood Lakes properties to SR 46 in Lake County, providing improved regional access among Seminole, Lake and Orange counties; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the Wekiva Parkway project in its entirety, the access to SR 429 at CR 435 in Orange County will be removed and access to SR 429 will be replaced with an interchange in Lake County at new CR 46A, just east of Camp Challenge; and

WHEREAS, there are potential negative impacts to the community of Mount Plymouth and to eastern Lake County when the access at CR 435 in Orange County is removed, due to traffic utilizing CR 435 into Lake County for access to the new interchange at the alignment of CR 46A; and

WHEREAS, a study of these potential impacts should be conducted by FDOT and said study is therefore required to be added to the FY 2018/19 - FY 2034/35 LOPP in order to be funded by FDOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lake~Sumter MPO:



2. The Chairman of the MPO is hereby authorized and directed to submit the list of priority projects to the Florida Department of Transportation and to the Chairman of both the Lake County and the Sumter County Boards of County Commissioners.
