Work Program. The Roll Forward TIP Amendment covers the gap between state and federal fiscal calendars for federally funded projects that were not committed/authorized during the previous state fiscal year. The Roll Forward Amendment ensures project information is reflected accurately in the TIP so federal funds can be authorized for project expenditure. Staff recommends approval of the Motion to approve the Emergency TIP Roll Forward Report Amendment.

A. Recommendation to the Board to be part of the Regional Transportation Management and Operations Program (RTSMOP). In March 2021, eight metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) in Central Florida formed an informal Regional Transportation System Management and Operations (TSMO) Working Group to share strategies on planning for TSMO, including congestion management. Members include MetroPlan Orlando (lead agency), Forward Pinellas, Hillsborough TPO, Pasco County MPO, Polk TPO, Sarasota/Manatee MPO, Space Coast TPO, and River-to-Sea TPO.

MPO staff recommends the MPO join with the M/TPOs to plan and advance TSMO strategies in partnership with the RTSMOP.

C. 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan Amendment #2 and Call for projects.

In August 2022, the MPO received a request from FDOT to amend the 2045 LRTP, adding a new project to the fiscally constrained list of Lake County roadway projects. An LRTP amendment is required when adding a regionally significant project that requires FHWA or FTA funding or approval, per the FDOT MPO Handbook. The details of the amendment appear in the attachment below. At this time, the MPO is requesting that the submission of any new county or municipal projects awarded using federal funds be included in this LRTP amendment process, which will begin in February 2023.
