



# Round Lake Road Widening & Extension

## From Lake/Orange County Line to North of S.R. 44

### You are invited to a public meeting

Lake County is holding a virtual and in-person public meeting on Thursday, April 22, 2021, at 6 p.m. regarding the Round Lake Road Widening and Extension Project (Meeting details are on the back). The purpose of this project is to relieve congestion and make safety improvements on Round Lake Road from the Orange County line to north of State Road (S.R.) 44. The project will add capacity and provide a contiguous north/south corridor that improves connectivity within the existing East Lake County transportation network. The public meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to view the current design plans underway.

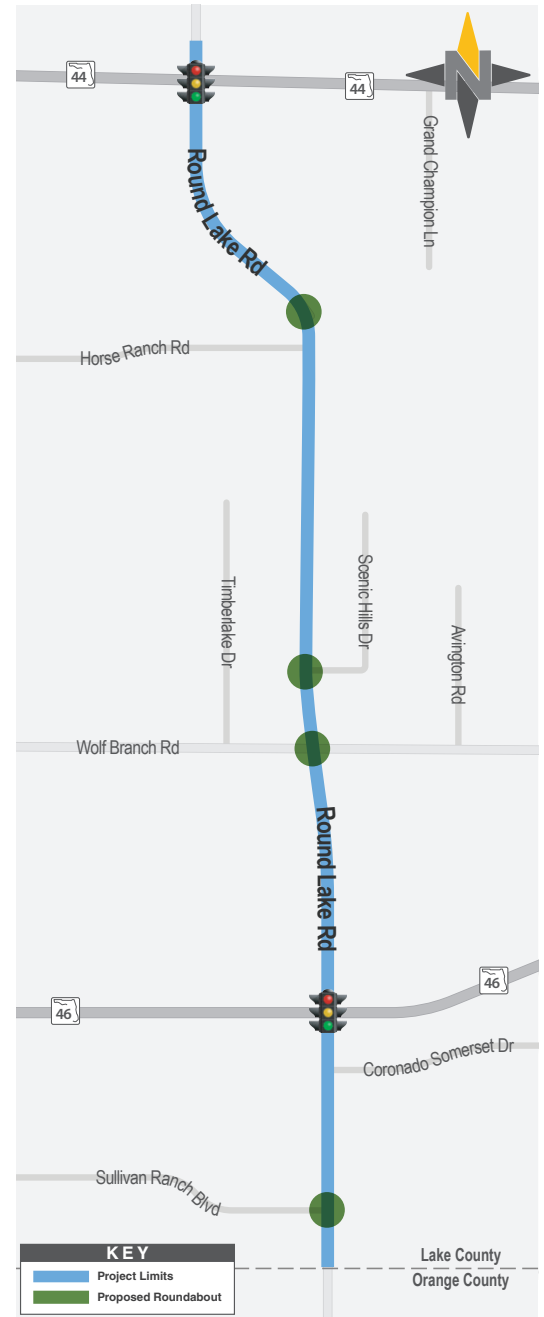

### Project Details

The proposed roadway will provide two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction, 5-foot-wide bicycle lanes, full and directional median openings, and dedicated left and right turn lanes in various locations of the project. The design will also include a 12-foot-wide multi-use trail and a 6-foot-wide sidewalk. The design follows the final alignment that was determined during the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study and approved by the Board of County Commissioners on May 7, 2019.

The project will be designed as a four-lane divided roadway. However, the Round Lake Road extension will initially be constructed as a two-lane roadway. It is anticipated that the project will include roundabouts at Sullivan Ranch Boulevard, Wolf Branch Road, Scenic Hills Drive and another location to be determined. Traffic signals will be located at the S.R. 46 and S.R. 44 intersections.

Attendees may come anytime between 6 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. to view a looping presentation and project displays, speak with project team members, and provide comments.
