D. 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) – Amendment – Call for Projects

During the 2022 Florida legislative session, a project appropriation for Citrus Grove Road Phase II was approved. As a result, project #435541-3 has been programmed in the FDOT Five-Year Work Program and will require an amendment to the LRTP to include in the Cost Feasible Plan and a TIP amendment to add it to the FY 2023-27 TIP.

The MPO will process the 2045 LRTP Amendment after January 1, 2023; any other projects that require an LRTP amendment should be included in this amendment process.
