IV. ACTION ITEMS

A. Selection of Lake County TDCB Vice-Chair

The TDCB shall hold an organizational meeting each year for the purpose of electing a Vice-Chairperson. The Vice-Chair shall be elected by a vote of the voting TDCB members. The Vice-Chair's term of office shall be for one (1) year starting with the first meeting after his/her election, but the Vice-Chair may be re-elected to an additional term or terms of office. In the event of the Chair's absence, the Vice-Chair shall assume the duties of the Chair and conduct the meeting. Lesha Buchbinder is the current Vice-Chair.

Staff recommends for the current Vice-Chair to be reappointed.

B. Review and Approval of the Lake County CTC Annual Operating Report (AOR)

The Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged (CTD) requires that CTCs submit the Annual Operating Report by September 15 of each year. The CTD evaluates and compiles the operating data provided by all CTCs, which is utilized to substantiate the need to seek Transportation Disadvantaged funds from the Florida Legislature.

The Lake County Transit AOR reflects the Office of Transit Services operating data for FY 2023-2024. The AOR must be approved by the CTD and then reviewed by the TDCB. The CTD has approved the Lake County Transit AOR for FY 2023-2024.

Staff recommends approval of the FY 2023-2024 AOR.

The CTD has stated that the CTC Evaluation Rider Survey may be revised for clarity and to ensure relevancy to Lake County's transit service. The survey has been revised based on TDCB member feedback and survey best practices. The updated survey has been reviewed by the CTC Evaluation Subcommittee and is being presented today for review and approval for use in the FY 2024-25 CTC Evaluation.

D. CTD Shirley Conroy Rural Area Capital Assistance Grant FY 24-25

As the Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC), the Lake County Board of County Commissioners qualifies for funding consideration through the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantage's (CTD) Shirley Conroy Rural Area Capital Assistance Grant Program. On May 21, 2024, the Office of Transit Services requested approval from the Lake County Board of County Commissioners to apply for the Shirley Conroy Grant for the purchase of a scheduling software upgrade for a cost of \$148,000. The CTD has awarded the grant to the County. The CTD will fund ninety percent of the grant request for a total of \$133,200 and the County ten percent match of \$14,800. The Office of Transit Services will need the Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board approval to move forward with the Grant Award.

Staff recommends approval to move forward with the Grant Award.

The Lake County TDCB is required to review the CTD Ombudsman's Report quarterly. The CTD received no calls for Lake County this quarter.

B. Sunshine Law and Ethics Training

The Lake-Sumter MPO Attorney will provide training on the Sunshine Law and how it applies to the TDCB.

C. Lake County Office of Transit Services Hurricane Preparation and Response

In September and October, Lake County was impacted by back-to-back hurricanes. Hurricane Helene made landfall on Florida's gulf coast on September 26, and Hurricane Milton followed less than two weeks later. Staff from Lake County Office of Transit Services will provide an overview of the critical role they play in hurricane preparation and response.



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E. Follow Up Items

This will be a recurring agenda item that provides a status update on items discussed at previous quarterly meetings. Due to Hurricane Helene and Hurricane Milton, as well as the FDOT Triennial Review that took place on November 5-6, Lake County staff have not been able to address the follow up items from the September meeting. These follow up items are documented below, and updates will be provided at the next TDCB meeting.

F. Section 5310/5311 Grant Applications

The Section 5310 and 5311 grant programs, described below, provide federal formula funding for transit-related activities. Lake County has the opportunity to apply for these grants.

- **FDOT Section 5310:** Programs for capital projects, designed and carried out to meet special needs of elderly and individuals with disabilities.
 - The Office of Transit Services is seeking approval from the Lake County Board of County Commissioners to apply for a FDOT Section 5310 Capital Grant for the purchase of four Turtle Top Odyssey Cutaway buses. The grant total request is \$760,460 with an 80% Federal share of \$608,368, the 10% State share of \$76,046, and the 10% County match of \$76,046. In addition, the Office of Transit Services will seek approval from the Lake County Board of County Commissioners to apply for a FDOT Section 5310 Operating Grant of \$800,000, with a 50% Federal share of \$400,000 and a 50% County match of \$400,000. In total, the Office of Transit services is applying for \$1,560,460 in FDOT Section 5310 Grant funding.
- **FDOT Section 5311:** Formula program that funds capital and operating assistance in rural areas.
 - The Office of Transit Services is seeking approval from the Lake County Board of County Commissioners to apply for a FDOT 5311 Operating Grant of \$800,000, with a Federal share of \$400,000 and a County local match of \$400,000.



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G. Annual Review of CTC Coordination Contracts

A Coordination Contract is a written contract between the CTC and an agency who receives transportation disadvantaged funds and performs some, if not all of, its own services, as well as services to others, when such service has been analyzed by the CTC and proven to be a safer, more effective, and more efficient service from a total system perspective. Lake County reviews each Coordination Contractor on an annual basis to evaluate performance and ensure compliance with applicable regulations.

Lake County is considering two new potential Coordination Contractor applicants who would like to be considered for Agreements. Lake County currently has Coordination Contracts with the following organizations:

JUSTIFICATION FOR EQUIPMENT REQUESTED (must include specific details supporting the need, the impact/value the equipment will provide to the coordinated system. If space provided is not enough for explanation of need, please attach an additional page):

The Lake County Board of County Commissioners serves as the designated Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) for Lake County, Florida, and is a complete brokerage system; contracting with RATP Dev USA to provide the Lake County Connection paratransit door-to-door service and LakeXpress fixed route service. The 2020 U.S. Census shows that 26.8% of Lake County's population is 65 or older and 10.3% have a disability, as opposed to Florida's statewide average of 21.6% age 65 or older and 8.7% with a disability. These statistics suggest Lake County will likely have more transportation-disadvantaged eligible customers than many other CTCs.

Lake County Office of Transit Services is seeking funding to purchase TripSpark's NovusDR scheduling software to provide rural paratransit services to the transportation-disadvantaged residents of Lake County, Florida. The primary objective of Lake County's request for funding is to replace our outdated Route Match software, which no longer has the necessary technology to grow with the County.

TripSpark's NovusDR software offers several paratransit customer benefits, including automated outbound notifications to confirm or cancel a trip, SMS text messaging, email, and phone notifications the day before and with the vehicle's imminent arrival. Customers will enjoy the 24/7 self-service online portal's ease of use, improved accuracy, and better customer service. Riders can view all upcoming and previously booked trips, and it will allow designated individuals to book and manage trips on their behalf. They can also set notification preferences for Interactive Voice Response (IVR) voice calls and SMS text messages. Visually impaired riders can use a screen reader to navigate the portal, book, review, confirm, and cancel trips, and select from previous trips and addresses to make bookings hassle-free. In addition, this software will allow customers to initiate a "ready early" pick-up request, review or edit their profile, and rate completed trips.

Lake County Transit will benefit from reduced no-shows and cancellations, driver wait times, call center hold times, and increased rider communications. The NovusDR software's main modules include client registration, trip booking and administration, vehicle management, driver management, real-time and batch scheduling, real-time dispatching, mapping and street management, reporting, and grant billing management.

Other benefits of the NovusDR software are real-time communication by providing the drivers with instant updates, manifest changes, better customer service to passengers with up-to-the-minute trip changes as trips are performed or rescheduled, a significant reduction in radio traffic, enabling drivers to view event locations on a Google or Waze map and obtain directions to event locations along with current traffic, street views, and full voice communicated turn-by-turn navigation. Additionally, the software can better handle same-day bookings, improve on-time performance, and increase passenger trips per hour.

The efficiencies outlined will ultimately increase customer service and satisfaction, increase provider productivity, and reduce operational costs to Lake County Transit, the Community Transportation Coordinator.

The total year-one project costs are estimated at \$213,352. Lake County Transit is requesting grant funding of \$133,505 (90%) of the total \$148,339 (100%) for system component licenses and services for the project. The 10% required local match of \$14,834 and other required year-one costs of software maintenance and remote hosting of \$65,013, totaling \$79,847, will be borne by Lake County Transit's Approved Budget and General Fund. Lake County will provide a 53.8% local match to the grant and 37.4% of the total project cost. The grant funding requested will provide 62.6% of the total project cost rather than the usual 90%.



Figure 1: Lake County Connection Preventable Accidents



Figure 3: Accidents and Roadcalls




Figure 5: Lake County Transit Trips



Figure 6: Trip Purpose



Figure 7: Passenger Types



Figure 8: Lake County Connection Passenger Types – Elderly



Figure 9: Lake County Connection Passenger Types – Other



Figure 10: Vehicle Miles








Figure 12: Lake County Connection Funding Source

Figure 13: Lake County Connection Contract Amount



Figure 14: LakeXpress Monthly Trips



Figure 16: LakeXpress Farebox Revenue





This new provision requires public transit providers to disclose certain information and documentation relating to its budgeted and general administrative costs. Beginning November 1, 2024, and every year thereafter, public transit agencies are required to report certain transit productivity and performance measures pursuant to Section 341.071(4)(b) and (d), F.S. Public transit providers receiving Florida Department of Transportation Transit Block Grant funding are required to report.
