This ad is to serve as legal notice that the Lake-Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization will be holding a Land Use Workshop on Wednesday, January 14, 2009 from 9:00 am to 12 Noon at the Lake County Agricultural Center, 1951 Woodlea Road, Tavares, Florida.

The Lake-Sumter MPO is about to embark on the significant task of developing its 2nd Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) which will look out to a horizon year of 2035. The purpose of this workshop will be to introduce two primary socioeconomic data sets for evaluation including population, employment, and school enrollment projections through 2035. This data will then be used to determine impacts to the transportation network and any needed improvements.

Two or more members of the Lake-Sumter MPO Governing Board or any other Board or Committee as well as elected officials from the area governments may be present and participate in the workshop.
