I. Review of Corridor

T.J. Fish gave an overview of the purpose of the C-470 Corridor Task force and a brief description of each of the sections of the corridor broken into the following segments:

- Sumter County C-470 – I-75 east to US 301
- Sumter County C-470 – US 301 east to Florida’s Turnpike (SR 91)
- Lake County CR 470 – Florida’s Turnpike east to CR 48/CR 33 intersection
- Lake County CR 48 – CR 48/CR 33 intersection east to US 27

II. Project Development Status Report

T.J. Fish provided an update on the status of the C-470 PER. He also provided details of the executed proportionate share agreement between Landstone Communities and Sumter County.

T.J. Fish provided an update on the status of the CR 470/CR 48 PD&E Study and Design. He discussed details of a request to FDOT for a grant for the CR 470 Bridge over Florida’s Turnpike

Details were also given for the major DRIs along and near the corridor that included current status and implications related to economic development.

III. Status of US 301 PD&E Study

T.J. Fish reported that FDOT was preparing to start a PD&E study for US 301 from C-470W to SR 44 in Sumter County. The PD&E is being coordinated with an Interchange Justification Report funded by Sumter County to support a new interchange on I-75 at CR 514.

IV. Discussions with FDOT on Jurisdictional Exchanges: US 301, SR 48 and C-470

T.J. Fish reported a discussion had been held with FDOT District 5 to discuss the opportunities for exchanging C-470 for US 301 and SR 48 with Sumter County.

V. Other Regional Transportation Projects Near the 470 Corridor

An status update was given for the major regional projects in the vicinity of the C-470 corridor.
