# **TASK FORCE ITEMS**

**I. US 441 PD&E Study Presentation** – Mary McGehee, FDOT, and Tara Jones, CH2M Hill, will present an update and seek input on the study, which looks at the potential of widening the four-lane facility to six lanes from SR 44 to SR 46 in Mount Dora. Since the study began in June, 2011, a public kick-off workshop was held on November 3, 2011. Significant input was received at that time requesting the incorporation of required frontage roads into the study process. Since then, the study team has been collecting data and preparing alternatives which will be presented at the next public meeting to be scheduled by May.
