Councilmember Norb Thomas called the meeting to order at 2 p.m. and noted that the meeting was properly noticed.

TASK FORCE ITEMS

I. Status of Road Projects

- SR 44 US 441 to Orange Avenue
 Mr. Fish stated construction funding for US 441 is several years out.
- SR 19 Downtown Eustis
 - Mr. Fish state we are looking to FDOT to meet with Umatilla and Eustis.
- SR 19 Little Lake Harris Bridge Update given by Mr. Fish.
- SR 19 Resurfacing (Altoona)
 - Mr. Fish discussed the need to update Umatilla comp plan.
- CR Old US 441 Downtown Tavares
 - Mr. Fish discussed interlocal agmt w/Lake Cty re: Old 441.
- CR 561 PD&E Study (Astatula)
 Mr. Fish stated the PD&E is almost complete.

II. Wekiva Parkway, Wekiva Trail and SR 46 Update

- Status of the PD&E Study
- Wekiva Trail Feasibility Study
- Tolling Concerns

Discussion regarding SR 44 and the 6 million cost compared to the original 20 million cost. The Wekiva Parkway needs a PD&E Study; and OOCEA announced the John Land Extension, Phase 2. Brief discussion regarding the Wekiva Trail Feasibility Study and the Tolling Concerns.

III. Orange Blossom Express – Steps to Commence Service

Discussion regarding continuous weld. Even without SunRail, the OB Express has the ability to stand alone. There will be an Alternatives Analysis joint with MetroPlan Orlando if SunRail passes through. Ben Biscan has been in contact with CSX. Brief discussion regarding rail and the MPO drafting the scope of alternatives analysis.

IV. LakeXpress

- Route 4 Kickoff July 1 (Altoona to Zellwood)
 Since July, the route has been performing okay.
- Route 1 (Spine Route) and Route 3 (Mount Dora Circulator) There is a two-year test.
- Golden Triangle Transit Plan
 We are wanting to get the Golden Triangle circulator running off the US 441 spine.
 Between Leesburg and Tavares is where most of the ridership is.

V. Project Prioritization – State Roads

• **SR 44** – US 441 to Orange Avenue (Mount Dora to Eustis)

- **SR 44** East of Orange Avenue toward St. John's River
- Wekiva Parkway & Wekiva Connector (replacing SR 46)
- **US 441** SR 44 to SR 46 (Mount Dora)
- **SR 19** CR 561 to CR 48 including LLH Bridge (Tavares to Howey)
- **SR 44** Orange Avenue to CR 46A (Eustis east)
- **SR 19** Downtown Eustis

Brief discussion ensued.

VI. Project Prioritization – County Roads

- **CR 561** SR 19 to CR 455 (Tavares to Eustis)
- CR 44 SR 19 west to US 441 (Eustis to Leesburg)
- **CR 44** and Eustis eastern bypass concept
- **CR Old 441** (Tavares to Mount Dora)
- CR 19A and Eudora Road and intersection with CR Old 441
- Round Lake Road (Mount Dora)
- **CR 437** Realignment (Mount Plymouth/Sorrento)
- **CR 46A** Realignment (East Lake Wekiva Area)

Mr. Fish briefly reviewed each road.

Mr. Fish covered new legislation affecting the Transportation Concurrency Management System.
