OPENING

Commissioner Tim Sullivan called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm and confirmed there was proper noticing. Introductions. Commissioner Sullivan commented on his recent trip to Washington D.C. and shared one of his meetings was with the Dept. of Transportation.

- **I. Trails -** T.J. Fish provided an update on the following trail projects. He commented it directly involves Lake County and actively closing gaps connecting regionally.
 - A. Wekiva Trail
 - 1. Northern Lake County Connection to Coast to Coast Trail
 - 2. Approved Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study
 - 3. Lake County and Mount Dora Memorandum of Understanding with Florida Central Railroad (FCEN) *Mr. Fish discussed the significance of the project and the need to extend the MOU. Discussion.*
 - 4. Segments Funded for Design Phase Neighborhood Lakes, Mount Plymouth/Sorrento, Mount Dora
 - 5. Right-of-Way Acquisition Process FCEN Role in Protecting Corridor; LC, MD & FDOT Funding Roles
 - 6. Segments Funded for Construction; Unfunded Segments
 - B. Tav-Lee Trail Construction Project in Downtown Tavares Project moving forward.
 - C. Tavares-Mount Dora Trail Feasibility Study (Tav-Dora?) *Study funds will be available July 1 next year*.
