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The LakeXpress Task Force meeting took place on the LakeXpress Route 3 Circulator Bus. The bus left the LakeXpress Ardice Transfer Station (Eustis Square) promptly at 2:38 p.m.

- I. Lake County Public Transportation Report Ken Harley gave a brief explanation of the LakeXpress Ardice Transfer Station. **David Hope** added the bus holds 26 sitting passengers and another 14 passengers can stand and use the hand rails.
- **II. MV Transportation Report -** None

III. MPO Staff Report - Michael Woods referred to the agenda packet which included a list of staff recommended locations for first 21 bus shelters. David Hope added that Public Transportation Staff has been installing all signage. T.J. Fish reported the importance of cities/municipalities working with county on maintenance issues. The MPO is in process of working on an ADA Compliance Study for all current and future bus stop and bus shelter locations in Lake County. The County Commission recently approved using Federal Stimulus funds (ARRA) for 20 shelters. Mr. Fish added the county is looking at installing solar powered shelters. David Hope added they will work with private shopping center owners while planning the shelter locations.

IV. Discussion Items –

- A. Bus Shelters comments included:
 - Shelters and more signage are needed.
 - The County will be working with the six muncipalities along the route on final design and location of the proposed shelters.
- B. TDP Update-(included in the agenda packet)
 - Due to the noise of the bus discussion was halted; the Taskforce was asked to just observe the bus in operation and the passengers as they utilized the system.
- C. Transit Technologies: (included in the agenda packet)
 - 1. Automatic vehicle locators
 - 2. Automatic passenger counters
 - 3. Vehicle cameras
 - 4. Fareboxes
- D. Ride Observation Survey members were asked to complete the survey.
