T.J. Fish provided information regarding the FDOT Tentative Work Program for 2019-23. He added FDOT is required to provide presentations. Project deferrals were discussed.

- B. Construction Project to Build to Six Lanes: US 27 from Lake Louisa Road (Clermont) south to Boggy Marsh Road (Four Corners/South Clermont)
- C. Groveland SR 50 Realignment Right-of-Way Funding Request
- D. Future FDOT Studies: US 27, SR 33, SR 19
- **III. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise:** Minneola Interchange, Mainline Widening, Bridges Staff provided update. Toll fees, SunPass and E-pass were discussed.
