T.J. Fish, Executive Director

T.J. Fish led a discussion on Public Transportation in South Lake. The discussion covered the 2012 Lake County Transit Development Plan Major Update, South Lake \$martRide, the Minneola Park & Ride Facility, and the LYNX partnership and vanpool program.
