North Hancock Road Extension - CR Old 50 to Lake Minneola High School (Design Funded in the current budget year FY 10/11, ROW and CST not funded.
Minneola Interchange on Turnpike (SR 91) – Prop Share Agreement Needed
Citrus Grove Road – US 27 to N. Hancock Road/Turnpike – Design needed
CR 561/561A Realignment - CR 455 to Turnpike (SR 91) – Study needed
Fosgate Road – US 27 to North Hancock Road – Partnership with landowner needed
CR 50/US 27 Intersection Improvements – Design/ROW FY 14/15
Hartwood-Marsh Road – US 27 to Hancock Road – Design needed
Hooks Street – US 27 to Hancock Road (Phase 4B, Grand Hwy. to Sand Hill Blvd.)
