  Pam Richmond asked that committee recommend endorsing as a working needs list. She noted that two projects were not included on the list and asked that they be added 1) SR 19 from Hwy 50 to CR 455, and 2) SR 50 from Hwy 98 in Hernando County to Hwy 33 in Lake County.
  MOTION was made by Denise Lee, seconded by Richard Baier motion passed 13 0.

- C. Recommend Approval of Central Florida MPO Alliance Regional Priorities by Resolution
  TJ Fish discussed the Central Florida MPO Alliance Regional Priorities MOTION was made by Aaron Mercer, seconded by Kyle Mills motion passed 13 0.
- D. Amend TAC Bylaws

After discussion **MOTION** was made by Jim Hitt to recommend the addition of a positon to the Governing Board and a positon to the TAC for CFX representation. The TAC position would be an ex-officio non-voting position. The Governing Board position also would be a non-voting ex-officio position, seconded by Richard Baier – **motion passed 13 – 0**.

E. Approval of the Request of FDOT to include Multi-use Trail on SR 44 Bridge
 TJ Fish discussed the requests of FDOT to accommodate a trail facility in the design and construction of a bridge to replace the existing SR 44 Bridge over the St. John's River. MOTION was made by Chris Schmidt, seconded by Stephen Cross – motion passed 13 – 0.
