

What is ETDM?

Florida's Efficient Transportation Decision Making (ETDM) Process is a new way of accomplishing transportation planning and project development for major capacity improvement projects. The ETDM Process enables agencies and the public to provide early input to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Metropolitan Planning organizations (MPOs) about potential effects of proposed transportation projects. The goal of ETDM is to make transportation decisions more quickly without sacrificing the quality of the human and natural environments.
