RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE~SUMTER METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) ADOPTING THE FY 2016/17 THROUGH FY 2034/35 LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS AND AUTHORIZING TRANSMITTAL OF THE NEW FUNDING PRIORITIES TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Lake-Sumter Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 49 U.S.C. require that the urbanized area, as a condition for the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, has a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175(8)(a), requires that the MPO is responsible for developing, annually, a list of project priorities and a transportation improvement program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation has established a deadline of August 1 for the submittal of new project priorities for funding from state FY 2016/17 through FY 2034/35, with said priorities serving as a basis upon which FDOT District 5 makes funding decisions relative to the FDOT five-year Work Program; and

WHEREAS, the Lake~Sumter MPO, serving the role of prioritizing all federal-aid roadways, also has prioritized county transportation projects for the purpose of communicating to each county the regional county transportation needs within the MPO Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lake~Sumter MPO:

1. The FY 2016/17 - FY 2034/35 List of Priority Projects is consistent with the MPO's 2035 Long Range Transportation Plan, which was adopted Dec. 8, 2010; and

2. The FY 2016/17 - FY 2034/35 List of Priority Projects is hereby endorsed and adopted; and
3. The Chairman of the MPO is hereby authorized and directed to submit the list of priority projects to the Florida Department of Transportation and to the chairman of both the Lake County and the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners.

RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE~SUMTER METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, AMENDING THE FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS (LOPP): REVISING THE PROJECT DESCRIPTION FOR C-466 FROM US 301 TO CR 209 FROM WIDEN TO FOUR LANES TO WIDEN TO THREE LANES IN TABLE 4B; DELETE THE C-466 FROM CR 209 TO I-75 PROJECT FROM TABLE 4B; REVISING THE FUNDED PHASE OF C-466 FROM C-475 TO US 301 FROM PD&E TO PES IN TABLE 3B; CHANGING THE PRIORITIZATION IN TABLE 9 OF THE DONNELLY STREET SIDEWALK, STREETScape AND STORMWATER PROJECT FROM FIFTH TO THIRD; CHANGING THE PRIORITIZATION ORDER IN TABLE 9 OF THE DONNELLY STREET SIDEWALK, STREETScape AND STORMWATER PROJECT, THE HIGHLAND STREET STREETScape PROJECT, AND THE TREMAIN STREET GREENWAY PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE AMENDED FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 LOPP TO THE APPROPRIATE AGENCIES.

WHEREAS, the Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Lake-Sumter Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175 and 23 U.S.C. 134 and 49 U.S.C. require that the urbanized area, as a condition for the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, has a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, annually the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the boards of county commissioners for Lake and Sumter counties adopt five-year work programs detailing the funding of phases for transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, F.S. 339.175(8) requires that a List of Priority Projects (LOPP), developed in conjunction with local governments' comprehensive plans, be produced annually, ranking the unfunded transportation needs of the MPO Area; and

WHEREAS, the MPO adopted the FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 LOPP for state funding for transportation projects on June 22, 2011, and transmitted it to FDOT; and

WHEREAS, Sumter County and The Villages have changed their focus of plans to construct an interchange at I-75 and C-466 to focus on an interchange at C-468 and Florida's Turnpike (SR 91); and

WHEREAS, this modification has resulted in a significant reduction in projected traffic volumes on C-466 from US 301 to I-75, amending the additional capacity need from four lanes along the segment from US 301 to CR 209 to three lanes, and resulting in no additional capacity need for the segment from CR 209 to I-75; and

WHEREAS, this modification removes the requirement to complete an environmental document that meets all federal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study that is being conducted for the C-466 from C-475 to US 301 project, will be converted to and completed as a Preliminary Engineering Study (PES); and

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Dora, at the August 16, 2011 City Council Meeting, changed the priority ranking of the City's three enhancement projects in Table 9 of the MPO's List of Priority Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Donnelly Street Sidewalk, Streetscape and Stormwater project, formerly the City's third enhancement project priority, is now its first priority; the Tremain Street Greenway project, formerly the first priority project, is now the second project priority; and the Highland Street Streetscape project, formerly the second priority project, is now the third priority.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lake~Sumter MPO that:

1. The FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 List of Priority Projects, Table 4B, is hereby amended to redefine C-466 from US 301 to CR 209, with the redefinition consisting of a change from a planned widening to four lanes to a planned widening to three lanes; and
2. The FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 List of Priority Projects, Table 4B, is hereby amended to delete C-466 from CR 209 to I-75; and
3. The FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 List of Priority Projects, Table 3B, is hereby amended to revise the phase of the C-466 from C-475 to US 301 project from a Project Development and Environment Study to a Preliminary Engineering Study; and
4. The FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 List of Priority Projects, Table 9, is hereby amended to change the ranking of the Donnelly Street Sidewalk, Streetscape, and Stormwater project from number 5 to number 3; and
5. The FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 List of Priority Projects, Table 9, is hereby amended to change the ranking of the Tremain Street Greenway project from number 3 to number 4; and

6. The FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 List of Priority Projects, Table 9, is hereby amended to change the ranking of the Highland Street Streetscape project from number 4 to number 5; and
7. The Chairman of the MPO is hereby authorized and directed to submit the amended FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 List of Priority Projects to the Florida Department of Transportation and to the chairmen of both the Lake County and the Sumter County Boards of County Commissioners.

16 **WHEREAS,** the Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the duly
17 designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and
18 programming process for Lake-Sumter Planning Area; and

19
20 **WHEREAS,** Florida Statutes 339.175 and 23 U.S.C. 134 and 49 U.S.C. require that the
21 urbanized area, as a condition for the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, has a
22 continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and
23 programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

24
25 **WHEREAS,** on an annual basis, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the
26 Board of County Commissioners for Lake and Sumter Counties adopt five-year work programs
27 detailing the funding of phases for transportation projects; and

28
29 **WHEREAS,** F.S. 339.175(8) requires that a List of Priority Projects (LOPP), developed in
30 conjunction with local governments' comprehensive plans, be produced annually, ranking the
31 unfunded transportation needs of the MPO Area; and

32
33 **WHEREAS,** the MPO adopted the FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 LOPP for state funding for
34 transportation projects on June 22, 2011, and transmitted it to FDOT; and

35
36 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2016/17 – 2034/35 LOPP was amended on August 24, 2011 to revise the
37 phase of the C-466 from C-475 to US 301 project from a Project Development and Environment
38 Study to a Preliminary Engineering Study in Table 3B; change the planned widening of C-466 from
39 US 301 to CR 209 from four lanes to a planned widening to three lanes and delete C-466 from CR
40 209 to I-75 widening project from Table 4B; and change the priority order of Donnelly Street
41 Sidewalk, Streetscape, and Stormwater project from number 5 to number 3, the Tremain Street
42 Greenway project from number 3 to number 4, and Highland Street Streetscape project from number
43 4 to number 5, in Table 9; and

44
45 **WHEREAS,** the South Lake Trail is an existing trail from Orange County west into Lake
46 County currently connecting the cities of Clermont, Minneola, Oakland, Winter Garden and Apopka;
47 and

49 **WHEREAS**, Phase 3A of the South Lake Trail is a 3.75 mile segment that begins at Silver
50 Eagle Drive in Groveland at South Lake High School and ends in Clermont connecting to the existing
51 West Orange/South Lake trail upon completion of construction; and

52
53 **WHEREAS**, the South Lake Trail is designed from South Lake High School through
54 downtown Groveland and is planned for construction west through Mascotte into Sumter County
55 connecting to the existing Van Fleet Trail; and

56
57 **WHEREAS**, the South Lake Trail is part of the Central Florida Loop, a 200-mile planned
58 regional trail connecting multiple counties and cities; and

59
60 **WHEREAS**, the South Lake Trail has always been the top enhancement project priority for
61 the Lake~Sumter MPO; and

62
63 **WHEREAS**, Phase 3A of the South Lake Trail has been programmed for \$2 million in federal
64 enhancement funding for construction in FY 2012/13; and

65
66 **WHEREAS**, the cost estimate for Phase 3A has increased by \$750,000; and

67
68 **WHEREAS**, a federal grant has been submitted to supplement the construction funding
69 shortfall; and

70
71 **WHEREAS**, the South Lake Trail project is no longer on the LOPP, but must be in order to
72 receive additional funding in the form of grants or other sources; and

73
74 **WHEREAS**, the Bushnell Citywide Bicycle/Pedestrian and Multi-Modal Enhancements
75 Project and Drainage Improvements (“Bushnell Project”) was added to the FY 2014/15 – 2024/25 List
76 of Priority Projects, adopted August 26, 2009; and

77
78 **WHEREAS**, the Bushnell Project received \$2,267,575 in transportation enhancement funding
79 in FY 2009/10 and an additional \$2,436,374 in FY 2010/11, increasing the total to \$4,703,949; and

80
81 **WHEREAS**, the Bushnell Project was broken into three phases at the request of the Southwest
82 Florida Water Management District to streamline the permitting process; and

83
84 **WHEREAS**, completed Phase 1 of the Bushnell Project was downtown park improvements
85 construction, completed Phase II was drainage improvements, and Phase III is to include sidewalks
86 and bike path construction; and

87
88 **WHEREAS**, Phase II of the Bushnell Project included a bid alternate for road resurfacing and
89 overbuild, milling, pavement markings, and architectural pavers on Florida Avenue, which would
90 provide a slope correction to move stormwater runoff to new inlets, stopping the buildings in the area
91 from flooding and preserving the life of the pavement; and

92
93 **WHEREAS**, the City of Bushnell entered into three Local Agency Program (LAP)
94 Agreements with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to construct the Bushnell Project
95 and received \$1,444,765 for Phase I, \$822,810 for Phase II, without the bid alternate, and \$2,237,921
96 for Phase III; and
