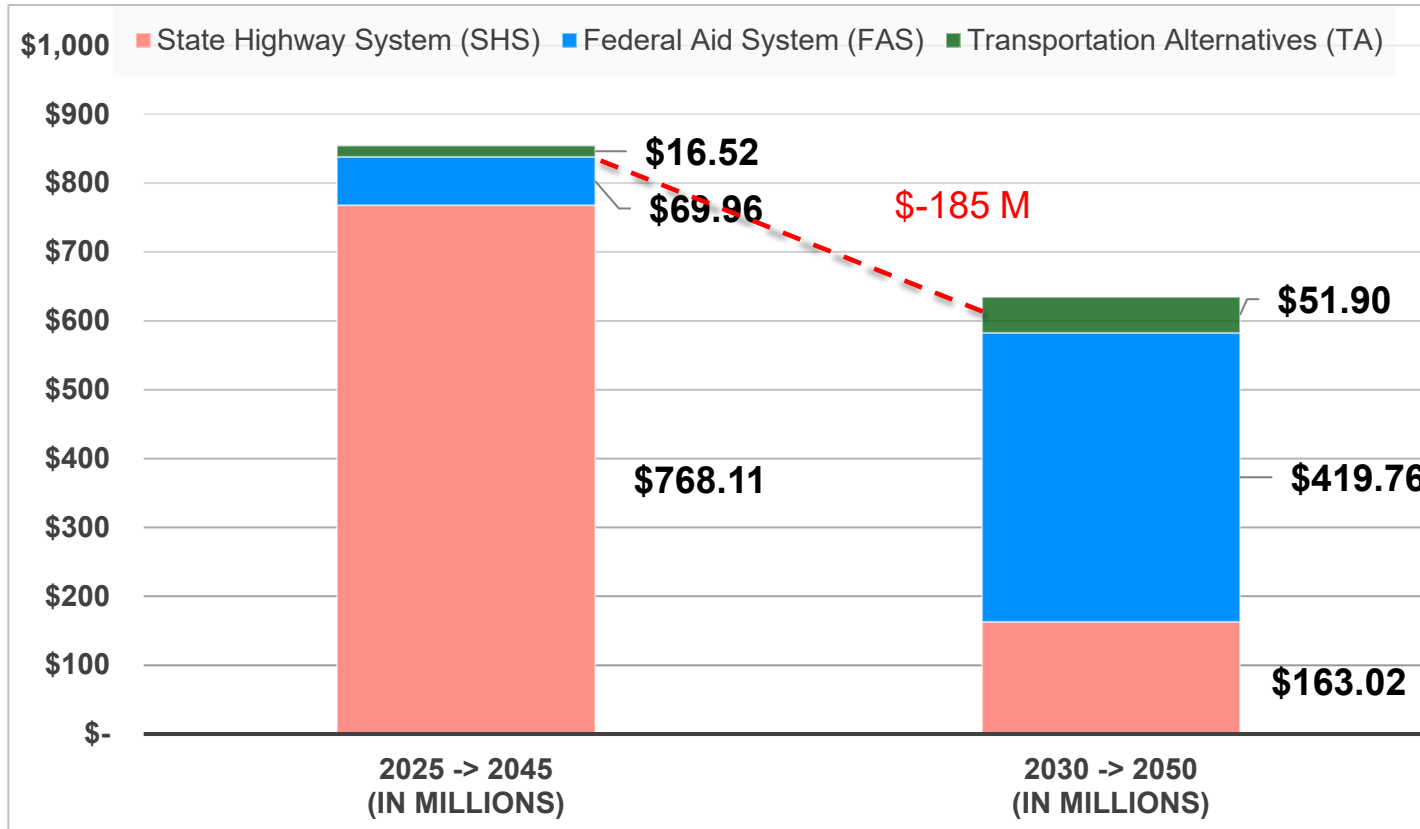

What is the List of Priority Projects?

- The List of Project Priorities (LOPP) is updated annually to identify LSMPO's **top priority projects** for inclusion in the TIP and FDOT Five-Year Work Program
- The 2026 LOPP is more streamlined with the 2050 LRTP – Cost Feasible Plan and other LSMPO documents



2050 Financial Forecast



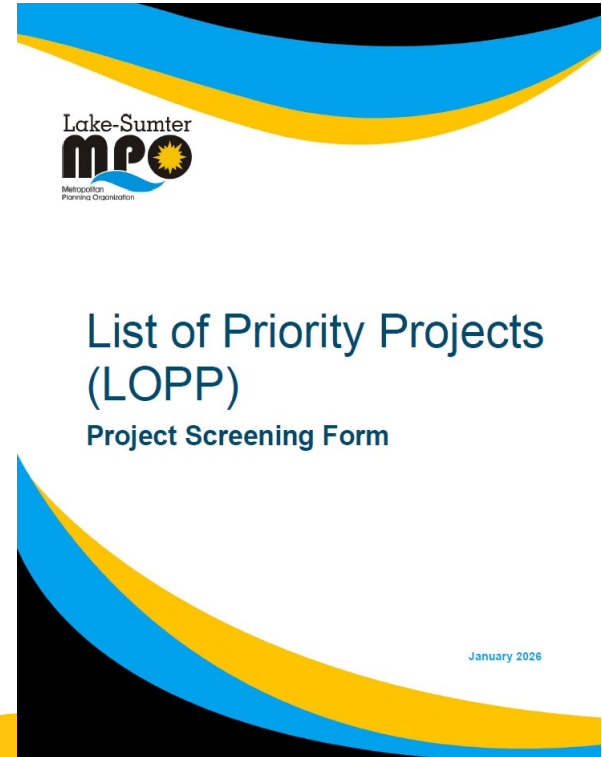
2026 List of Priority Projects

- The 2026 LOPP is the **first 10 Years** of the 20 Year Long Range Transportation Plan - Cost Feasible Plan
- As projects are funded, both the LRTP and LOPP will be amended
- Central Parkway Widening removed from LOPP – now Fully funded with local funds

- ✓ 2 projects received and reviewed
- 2050 LRTP & LOPP will be amended next fiscal year



Project Prioritization

- All projects submitted through the Call for Projects Form and Dashboard will be subject to **LSMPO project prioritization process**
- Do projects reflect 2050 LRTP goals & objectives?
- LSMPO ranks projects, but the Board makes final ranking decisions

2050 LRTP Goals

Goal	Goal Definition
 Economy	Support economic development and tourism.
 Safety	Increase safety of the counties' transportation system.
 Mobility	Provide for mobility needs of the community.
 Intermodal	Maintain existing transportation system.
 Livability	Preserve, and where possible, enhance social, cultural, physical, and natural environmental values.
 Preservation	Preserve and maintain a resilient transportation infrastructure and transit assets.
 Implementation	Effectively execute strategies and actions to achieve the county's transportation system goals, ensuring measurable progress and adaptability.

Local Agency Program (LAP) Projects

- All LAP projects (off system) need an **updated** FDOT Project Information Application (**PIA**)
- Includes **2026 LOPP projects** and any **TA projects** that get approved by the Board
- **Deadline for Submission: Wednesday, May 20, 2026**

Transportation Alternative (TA) Screening

- ✓ **Bevilles Corner Intersection** Improvements - should move forward
- **CR 476 Resurfacing** is a pavement project – may not meet TA criteria
- **Center Hill CR 48** – needs Sumter County (maintaining agency) support and sponsorship

TA Project Application

- LSMPO needs to upload TA project PIAs into GAP system by **June 30th**
- TA project sponsors will need to **complete/upload** a current **TA project application** into **GAP system** during submission cycle (**July 15th – August 15th, 2026, TBD**)

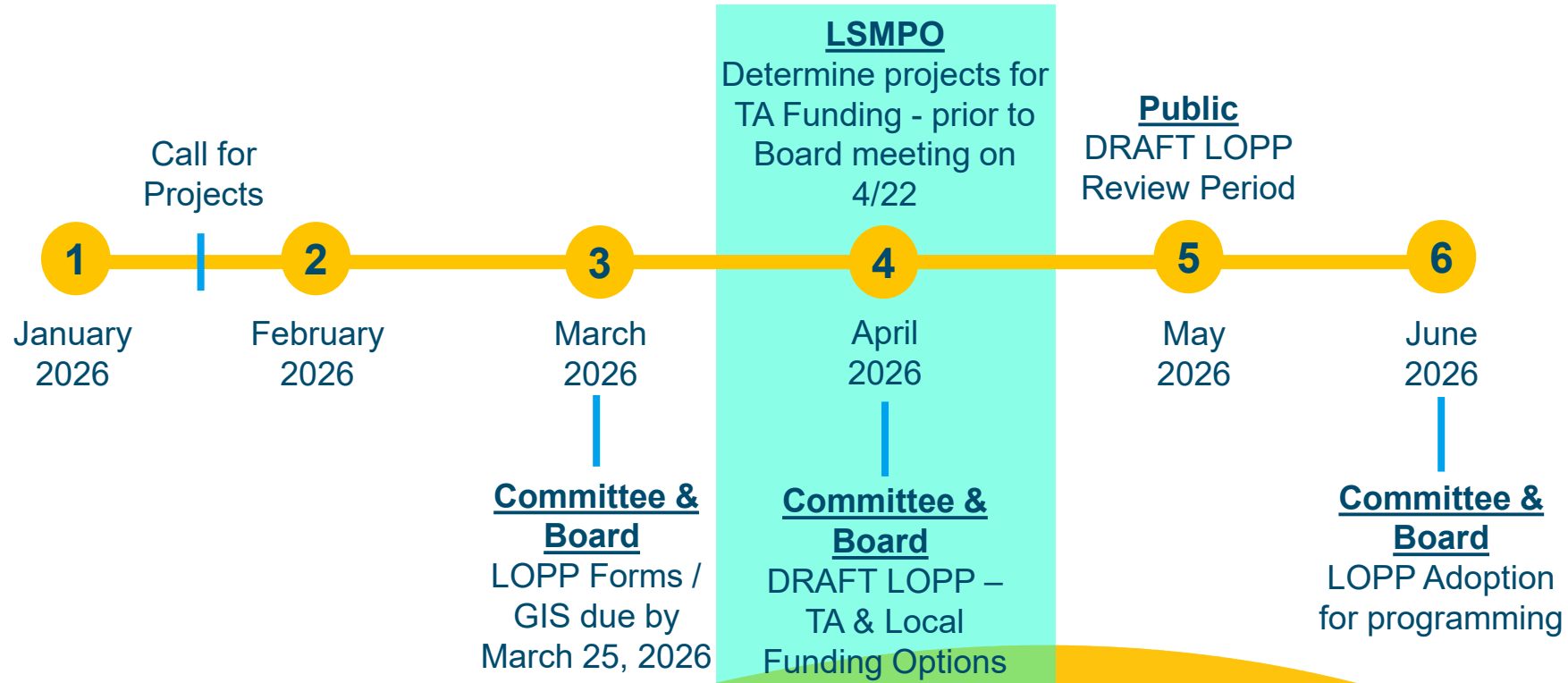
